Since 1978, the Community Foundation has been the premier charitable partner trusted by thousands of generous Northern Virginians.

Our mission is to respond to critical need and seed innovation in the region. Comprised of donor advised funds, community investment funds, scholarship funds, and giving circles, we help engage donors in community, meet community needs with community resources, and strengthen Northern Virginia.

Our Community Foundation serves the entire region, including Arlington, Fairfax, Loudoun and Prince William Counties and the Cities of Alexandria, Fairfax, Falls Church, Manassas and Manassas Park.

During the 2016 fiscal year, the Community Foundation awarded \$4.6 million + in grants and scholarships – a record level of giving. But we decided many years ago that we would not measure our success simply by the amount and number of grants and scholarships we award each year. Community leadership is a core competency of our organization as well.

The Community Foundation commissions and publishes data driven research reports on the real needs of the region. We convene the community to help address complex and persistent issues. We engage in cross-sector collaborations. And we help the community apply strategic thinking to the distribution and use of our precious local resources.

Whether we are awarding grants, leading a broad-based community coalition, or publishing research on the critical needs of Northern Virginia, we do nothing alone. Together we create lasting change to help transform the region.
